

Working with the New ArcGIS Online Map Viewer

Overview

ArcGIS Online and Portal have a new Map Viewer app, with a great new interface for creating and sharing maps. This workshop will introduce to you the new interface, help you find all the buttons and tools you are used to, and see what's new. You will learn how to create maps, work with symbology, create labels, run filters, and edit features in the new app. You'll also learn to create charts in AGOL and Portal.

Topics Covered

- Creating Web Maps – Understanding how to create web maps in the new map viewer. (Creating a Web Map; Finding and Adding Data; Browsing Online Data and the Living Atlas)
- Symbols, Editing, and Printing – Getting familiar with all of the basic necessities. (Setting and Changing Display Properties; Filtering the Data; Using Clustering Symbology; Configuring Pop-Ups; Configuring Labels; Editing Features; Editing Attributes; Using the Field Calculator; Sharing and Printing)
- Charts in AGOL – Analyzing trends in the data using charts. (Creating and Accessing Charts; Chart Symbology; Configuring Bar, Scatter, and Series Charts; Histograms; Chart Display Settings)
