

Introduction to VertiGIS Studio Printing

Course Length: 1 day (instructor-led)
5 days (self-paced)

Overview

This one-day course builds on your knowledge of VertiGIS Studio and teaches you how to configure custom print templates using VertiGIS Studio Printing controls. You'll learn how to create effective page layouts that can be used to generate printed maps from VertiGIS Studio Web applications, including dynamic input from users.

Audience

Those who are already familiar with VertiGIS Studio and want to learn how to create custom print templates that can be called from a web application.

Topics Covered

Day 1

- VertiGIS Studio – An overview of VertiGIS Studio and the benefits of the VertiGIS Studio capabilities. Explore multiple examples of generating printed maps from within an app.
- VertiGIS Studio Printing – Discuss where print templates are created, benefits of using VertiGIS Studio Printing, and how to use it. Describe the key features and get acquainted with the VertiGIS Studio Printing Designer interface.
- Creating a Print Template – Identify the steps to create a print template. Describe page layout design considerations. Create a simple print template. Preview a print template from within VertiGIS Studio Printing. Run a print template from a VertiGIS Studio Web app.
- Configuring a Print Template – Locate property settings for a print template. Configure properties for a variety of controls. Learn how to request input from the user to be added to the generated print at runtime.
- Designing a Print Template – Practice creating and customizing your own print template.

Format

This course is available as an in-person or remote instructor-led course, or as a self-paced course, with hands-on practice and course materials you can keep.

Prerequisites and Recommendations

- Fundamental knowledge of VertiGIS Studio technologies.

- Basic understanding of mapping principles.
- Familiarity with creating and sharing content in ArcGIS Online or Portal for ArcGIS.
- Knowledge of building apps in VertiGIS Studio Web.
- Experience with VertiGIS Studio Reporting concepts is helpful.
- We recommend using two monitors for an ideal learning experience.
